# A LIVING MEMORIAL TO DYNAMISM

Great men are remembered long after they are gone. Legends and immortality are shaped as a consequence of their deeds.

For seventy-two years Fr. Aurelius Maschio demonstrated a rare compassion and nurtured excellence especially amongst the youth and the underprivileged. His life and his deeds must be enshrined to serve as a motivatizon for people to grow, to dare, to excel. To meet this basic objective, the Salesian Province of Bombay has setup the Fr. Maschio Memorial Foundation, which while continuing to propagate the charisma of Don Bosco, will target the poor, the young and the marginalised as its mission. The Foundation will enter into partnerships with non-partisan agencies and Salesian Communities to work for the welfare and development of the poor and the young in India. The Foundation has already received blue prints for various projects and approved them for support and funding.

The Nowhere Child: It is estimated there are over 40,000 homeless, runaway children who survive on their own work as rag pickers and hotel boys in Mumbai. They suffer from malaria, tuberculosis, dog bites, skin diseases and injuries from street fights and gang brutalities. The street children, by definition, have no relatives. There is no agency which offer infirmary services for street children in Mumbai. The Maschio Foundation plans to set up a 15-bed infirmary for street children, the homeless and slum youth which will provide immediate medical attention and referral to relevant hospitals. The management of the infirmary will use the period of the street child's stay at the infirmary to provide health education and recreational facilities in an endeavour to help the child regain his lost childhood.

Lifeline for the child: Childline-- The purpose is to reach out promptly to children in distress and link them with the most appropriate source of help available in the city. The CHILDLINE is a four digit, easy to remember number, toll free and any child can use it from any part of greater Mumbai. A large number of police personel at various levels have been oriented and the effort is on to make the police force child friendly and direct them in helping children in distress. The Maschio Foundation will join this effort as part of a collective expression of care, reaching out to street children in distress.

Fr. Maschio Annagyan Yojna: (Meal A Day Scheme for street children). A new initiative of Shelter Don Bosco which has done pioneering work in the area of providing various programmes for street children. It will provide the street children an opportunity to take part in a host of activities including, non formal functional literacy, basic medical treatment, need-base awareness programmes, recreation, impart training in various skills for the street children and explore the possibilities of re-habilitation and connecting these children with their parents.

Encouraging Excellence: Realising that deserving students need financial help, the Foundation is initiating the Fr. Maschio Scholarship Scheme to support deserving students who cannot pursue higher studies. The Fr. Maschio Scholarship scheme is envisaged to fund studies and research such as integrated rural development, afforestation, agroforesty, soil and water conservation, alternate and cost effective sources of energy, holistic health, indigenous medical systems, AIDS, detoxification, child, labour, women and child development, innovations in education in favour of the poor school dropouts as care areas.

Rewarding Achievements: The Maschio Foundation also plans to institute Lifetime achievement Awards (LAA) of Rs. 1 Lakh each to be given to individuals or bodies who have been working for the underprivileged and dispossessed, whose contribution and innovation needs to be recognised and supported. Nominations will be received from NGOs and the Board of the Maschio Foundation will decide of the Award List.

Innovative Initiatives: The Maschio Foundation plans to launch dynamic initiative that will foster the mission of Fr. Maschio. The proposal under consideration is a system to encourage youth to enter government public services. Today our youngsters do not volunteer to serve in the governance of the country. The Maschio Foundation plans to involve themselves in workshop and other schemes to disseminate information, create awareness and expose youth to these career options.

**Training Women in Skills for Income-Generating Activities:** The Fr. Maschio Foundation is giving women a boost -- to their economy, their ego, their confidence, by extension of many homes that will be kept afloat by a women's economic independence and this will be a testimony to the helping hand of the Maschio Foundation.

The Watershed Projects: In the regions around Madhya Pradesh, Maharashtra, the project has already proved a success much to the amazement of many other government bodies. It helps villages provide for themselves with water during the draught ridden months of the summer.

# THE MAN FOR TOMORROW FR. JOSEPH CASTI, S.D.B., SUCCESSOR TO THE FOUNDER REV. FR. AURELIUS MASCHIO.

Rev. Fr. Joseph Casti s.d.b. a veteran Salesian born in Italy at Rieti, nr Rome in 1931, joined the Salesians in 1947 at Varazee and arrived in Panjim, Goa already a Priest in 1958 to begin his India odyssey.

He made this country his home and successfully launched a host of projects. In 1968 Fr. Casti helped build the church and hostel in Panjim and initiatives to lay the foundation of Salesian activities in Goa. After a stint as the Salesian Vice Provincial in Mumbai he left for Rome to undertake his Doctorate in Theology at Urbaniana University. He returned to continue as the Vice Provincial and was later appointed Novice Master in Nasik from 1978 - 1990. After a Sabbatical spent in New York at Fordham University and in San Francisco at the institute for integral studies, Fr. Casti come to India as Rector of Provincial House, Mumbai and Assistant to Fr. Maschio, a post he held till he succeeded him as Rector of the Shrine of Don Bosco's Madonna and Director of Fr. Aurelius Maschio Mem. Foundation and various Projects.
