

The life and the sacrifice of the monk, martyred at age 39, is exemplary. His uncompromising love for the youth, his patriotism, deep faith and the spirit of Don Bosco led him to gallows during the Communist dictatorship. He was born on 26 November 1914. At age 25, he submitted his religious application to the Salesian order. In 1952 ÁVH/SPA (State Protection Authority) arrested him. On the score of conspiracy against the state and overthrowing the democratic order, the court-martial sentenced him to death by hanging. He was executed on 8 June 1953, his corpse was thrown into an unmarked grave.



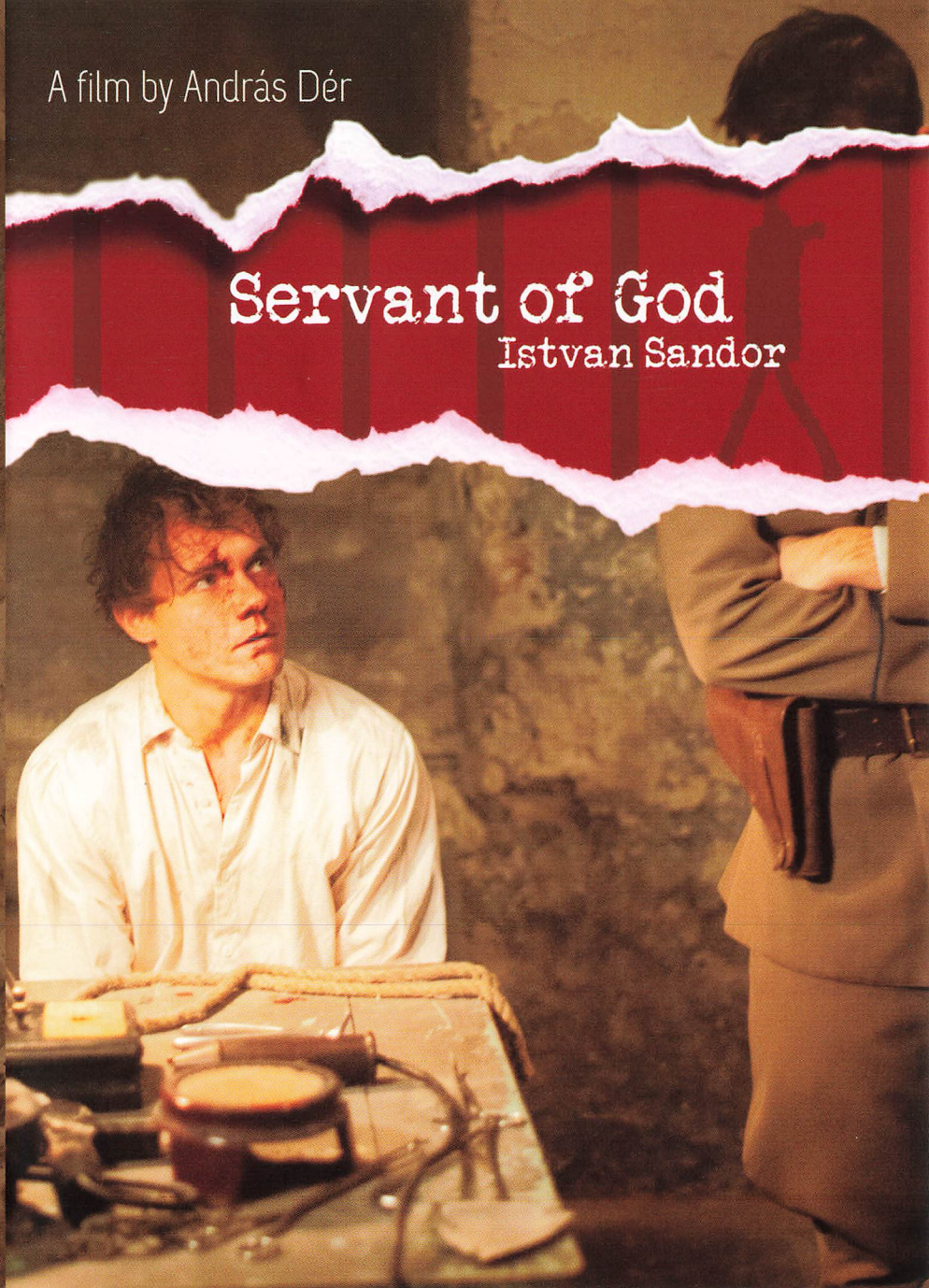
